

Bloomfield Central School Capital Project Information

The Bloomfield Central School District has begun construction on the Capital Improvement Project that was approved in October of 2019. Phase 1 of this project began in December and will continue into the summer. Phase 1 work includes: renovations of bathrooms in both buildings and the addition of gender neutral toilet rooms at the M/HS, a new learning center and operations offices in the old District Office space, the addition of a hydroponics classroom, locker-room updates at the M/HS, renovation of the student lounge area, renovation of the small cafeteria at the M/HS, grinding and polishing terrazzo floors in both buildings, installation of new water bottle fill stations in both buildings, installation of a new dust collection system in the M/HS technology wing, the addition of a mezzanine for additional storage in the PAC, a new sound system in the PAC and new carpet in the PAC and music rooms. **One of the larger projects embedded in phase 1, installation of a new primary and intermediate playgrounds at the ES, will begin June 22, 2021. During construction the playgrounds will be closed to the public. We apologize for the inconvenience this may create this summer, but we look forward to new handicap accessible playgrounds that should be open for use this September.** Updates on this project can be found in the Bloomfield Central School District *District Gram* each month.

Phase 2 of the Capital Improvement Project is scheduled to begin in the next few days. Phase 2 work includes: the additions of handicap accessible walkways by the upper athletic fields, installation of bleacher pads, new District signage, landscaping of the Stadium Hill, renovation work to create a large group instruction room at the M/HS, work on the HS main gym floor (sanding, re-painting and sealing), and repairs of the loading docks at both schools. **One of the larger projects embedded in phase 2 of the project includes: renovations of the 3 current tennis courts, the addition of 3 new courts and the addition of a storage building in the tennis court area that will contain restrooms. With construction occurring in the tennis court area we will need to close that area to the public. This will include the closure of the walking path between the M/HS and the ES to the public for safety reasons. Again, we apologize for the inconvenience this closure creates, but we look forward to re-opening that area which will soon contain a restroom and 6 tennis courts for school and community use.** We anticipate that this area will be reopened sometime in October or early November.
